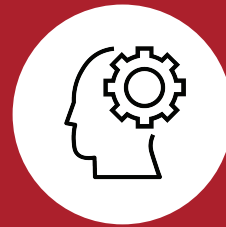
WHAT ARE UNION LEARNING OUTCOMES?

Students will dive deeper into researching potential career options, industries, and job roles to make informed decisions about future career directions.



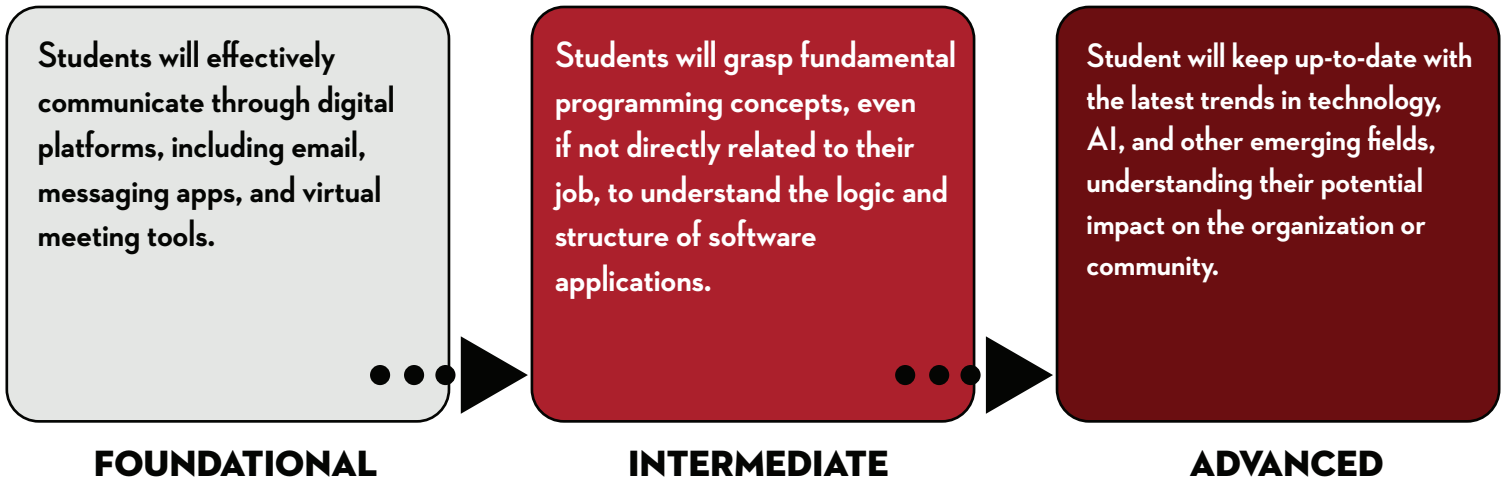
Students will develop a comprehensive career plan that aligns skills, experiences, and goals with long-term career aspirations, considering potential advancement opportunities and skills gaps.
