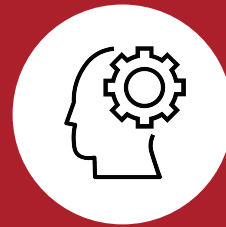
WHAT ARE UNION LEARNING OUTCOMES?
